The graduate labour market in Liverpool – and beyond

Dr Charlie Ball, Head of Higher Education Intelligence, Graduate Prospects

Dr Charlie Ball is the Head of Higher Education Intelligence at Graduate Prospects, the sector agency charged with the support of higher education careers and employability provision, and where he is the specialist on UK graduate employment and the skilled jobs market.

Charlie publishes and speaks extensively on all issues on the graduate and postgraduate labour



market, and works extensively with quantitative data on graduates.

He is a member of steering groups and advisory boards for a number of sector organisations, including AGCAS, HESA, the HEA and the Office of National Statistics, as well as sitting on the Institute of Student Employers' research advisory group.
