Here are some important updates regarding the Vevox voting system.

If you use the Vevox Powerpoint Add-in

Accessing the add-in

Last year the Vevox PowerPoint add-in was preinstalled on all PCs. So you could open PowerPoint and find Vevox tab ready to use. Apologies, a recent update means that this is not possible at the moment.

If you need the PowerPoint Add-in please open this from the JMU app player before launching PowerPoint and it will install ready for you to use.

Vevox has promised an update in October 2019 which will allow us to have this installed on all PCs again. I will email you again to tell you when this work has been completed.
