

## **Articulation Key:**

- □□□ skill not articulated, no evidence presented.
- demonstrated ability to answer reflective questions and reflect on skill but no articulation of skill confidence. e.g. can discuss thoughts and feelings about skills and reflect on what they found easy or hard, and what they might do differently.
- demonstrated ability to answer reflective questions and reflect on skill and some articulation of skill confidence but could develop more positive language. e.g. as above for reflection AND may use statements that could be phrased more positively such as "I feel I am a good communicator" or "During the group work I had to work with four other students".
- demonstrated ability to answer reflective questions and reflect on skill and ability to articulate skill with confidence. e.g. as above for reflection AND articulates skill confidence positively such as "I am a good communicator" or "During the group work I successfully worked with four other students".
